



Boarding Checklist

Hi! Thank you! I am honored that you have selected Dog Paws Boarding Resort, LLC. to care for your cherished 4-legged kiddo(s) while you are away.

In an effort to make this stay as stress free as possible I've created this checklist as a guide while you prepare for Boarding!

Required Items

- Complete your Reservation request online.
- Completed Boarding Intake Application Form and attend pre-boarding tour for new clients.
- Completed Boarding Contract Agreement and Veterinarian Release forms.
- Provide copies of vaccine records, fecal exams, proof of flea/tick medications.
- Dogs need to be on leash/harness/in carrier upon arrival and pickup to ensure their safety.
- Cats need to be in an enclosed carrier upon arrival and pickup to ensure their safety.
- Food must be provided in a sealed storage container and clearly labeled with Kiddo(s) and Owner name on it.
- Medication or Supplements to be administered should be provided in its original marked container and clearly labeled with Kiddo(s) name and Owner name on it.
- Determine any extra services you wish to receive on the Boarding Intake Application Form.

Optional Items

- Feeding Bowls. Dog Paws Boarding Resort, LLC. provides stainless steel bowls. If you'd like to bring your own food bowls, please be sure that you clearly label them.
- Blankets/Bedding. Feel free to bring your kiddo(s) favorite bink! For safety, all blankies must be free of "stuffing".
- Toys. Feel free to bring a couple favorite toys! We cannot be held responsible for lost or damaged items. For safety, rawhides are not allowed.
- Treats. Please ensure that any special treats are in a sealed storage container/baggie and clearly marked with Kiddo(s) and Owner name.
